Goondiwindi's Border Rivers Christian College set to receive \$615,000 in Federal Government funding to improve learning areas

Border Rivers Christian College students in Goondiwindi will soon have a new administration building, sick bay and sports area thanks to \$615,000 in Federal Government funding, Maranoa MP David Littleproud announced today.

"The Border Rivers Christian College was approved \$615,000 for two projects under the Capital Grants Programme to assist the school to improve its administration infrastructure and build a new undercover sporting area," Mr Littleproud said.

"This funding will ensure students will have the infrastructure necessary to help them get the most from their time at the Border Rivers Christian College.

"The Liberal National Coalition Government is committed to improve the quality of our school education and ensure regional students are equipped with the skills needed to succeed."

Goondiwindi's Border Rivers Christian College project details:

Project one: Construction of an administration building consisting of a reception, offices, work area, sick bay, staff room, store room, meeting room, amenities, veranda, furniture, equipment and site works.

Project two: Construction of undercover and sports area and site works.
