Littleproud MP urges the South-West to be ready for the Queen's Baton Relay

The Federal Member for Maranoa, David Littleproud, is urging the South-West Queensland community to get behind the Queen's Baton Relay as it passes through Birdsville, Roma, Mitchell, Morven, Charleville and Augathella between 7 and 9 March 2018.

The Queen's Baton Relay will kick off in Australia on Christmas Day in Canberra before making its way around Australia, arriving in Queensland from 3 March 2018 on its last leg to the Gold Coast in time to officially open the XXI Commonwealth Games.
