Security lighting to be installed at Nanango RSL sub-branch Maranoa MP announces

Deterring crime and helping to keep our communities safe are the goals for Maranoa MP David Littleproud who today announced \$7548 for Nanango's RSL sub-branch to install security lighting.

"Previously lights were smashed which gave criminals opportunities to slash tires and steal vehicles from the RSL Sub-Branch in Nanango - that's why this project is so important for the community to once again regain this space from criminal activity," Mr Littleproud said.

"The Nanango RSL is strongly supported by locals, and supports our veterans – this organisation, its carpark and hall can no longer be a target of crime or vandalism.

"Security lighting will certainly help us stay vigilant about who is around and, more importantly, deter criminals from breaking and entering an establishment that is there to serve and support our community needs.

"The beauty of the Safer Communities program is that it is funded by criminals themselves, through Proceeds of Crime, and invested back into our community for safety programs.

"This program is one of five in Maranoa funded with \$881,649 which was secured through the Safer Communities program."
